No charge for immunizations for children birth – 18 years of age and in high school. Your children's immunization records are very important. Without the records, we cannot give immunizations. If there are absolutely no immunization records, the child's entire series of immunizations will have to be started over. If available, please bring your child's social security card.

If you have Health Care District, Medicaid, or other insurance, please bring the card with you. There may be a waiting time prior to getting the shots, please bring a snack for your child to eat.

ATTENTION PARENTS: If your child is going into K or 7<sup>th</sup> grade next year, he/she may need immunizations. Please don't wait, get them now.

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## PBC Childhood Immunization Requirements

Florida Certificate of Immunization, Form DH 680 is the only document that the schools are permitted to accept as proof of immunization.

### Kindergarten - 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP) – 5 doses
- Polio (OPV or IPV) – 4 doses (the last one after age 4)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella – 2 doses (usually given as 2 doses MMR)
- Hepatitis B (Hep B) – 3 doses

### Kindergarten, First, Second Grade & Third Grade

- Varicella – 2 doses or provider verification of Chickenpox disease history on form DH 680

### 4<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> Grade:

- Varicella – 1 dose or provider verification of Chickenpox disease history on form DH 680

### 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> Grades (entry or repeating, if not given previously)

- Tetanus/Diphtheria & Pertussis booster (Tdap) – 1 dose
- 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Grade
- Tetanus / Diphtheria, (Pertussis) (Tdap) or Tetanus, / Diphtheria (TD)

### Pre-K Programs (age appropriate doses as indicated)

- Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP)
- Polio (OPV or IPV)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Haemophilus Influenza, type B (Hib)
- Hepatitis B (Hep B)
- Varicella (VZV)

### Licensed Child Care Facilities and Family Day Care Homes

Children entering or attending Licensed Child Care Facilities and Family Day Care Homes shall have received as many of the following age-appropriate immunizations as are medically indicated in accordance with the current Recommended Childhood Immunization Schedule:

- Diphtheria/ Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP)
- Polio (OPV or IPV)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Varicella (VZV)
- Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (Hib)
- Pneumococcal Conjugate (Prevnar) for children age 2 to 59 months
- Hepatitis B (Hep B) (Recommended)
